Educational Advisory Board Toolt was noted that the CSU chancellor's office offered to pitch in a large portion of the purchase price for a student success management tool system from EAB. This tool creates a customized, predictive model for each student so that the advisors can identify at-risk students and isolate systemic barriers to degree completion.
