This proposal was the result of over a year of discussion and consultation with the General Education Advisory Committee (GEAC) Chair. It is an extraordinary proposal that is only applicable for extraordinarily high-unit majors like Mechanical Engineering and should not serve as precedent for other majors at Cal Maritime. Furthermore, any recommendation to meet a Golden Four class in major must be
