- Yip would there be seating in the Bistro? Cooper elaborated on this, noting that it would be restricted as necessary, but the plan is for at least some seating.
- McNie complimented them on their sensitivity to the sustainability and diet issues. Cooper noted that there would also be kosher food in partnership with Touro University.

A/V Support, VPAT Process, and Infrastructure Plans (Julianne Tolson, CIO)

- Pinisetty presenting the issues. A/V support struggles particularly during pandemic. This has been problematic - little support, and some big problems in some converted classrooms (Compass, Rizza).
- Pinisetty VPAT issues: some consistency and some clear expectations on requirements and timeline. There were some particular issues with software used for adapting to pandemic teaching.
- o Lastly, continuing WiFi issues in Maritime North and in the faculty offices.
- Tolson staffing has been a challenge. Some quarantines, some personal leaves, etc. They do have a new person who is great, but
