4. Withdrawal Unauthorized (WU)

A gradeof "WU" (equivalent o an "F" grade for cumulative and semester grade int average computation) will be assigned o a student who is enrolled on the census date, does not officially withdraw from a course but fails to complete it or has a significant number of class absence after the fourth week. In courses which are grade Credit/NoCreditor in cases where the student has elected Credit/NoCredit evaluation use of the symbol "WU" is in appropriate and "NC" shall be used instead. It is the student's responsibility to officially withdraw from a course in which he/she has registered yet never attended or has
