

# Open University Policy

**Procedures:**

**A. Enrollment in Open University:**

Enrollment is open to non-matriculated students only.

1. Former Cal Maritime students who have been inactive (matriculation closed) or graduated (alumni).
2. Students who have been academically disqualified from Cal Maritime or other institutions.
3. International or non-resident students not enrolled in

5. Open University students will be issued a temporary Cal Maritime email address and access to university learning platforms which may be required for the course(s). Upon completion of the semester, students may view their grades online or request an official Cal Maritime transcript.
6. Open University students must comply with university and department regulations regarding prerequisites, withdrawals, repeats, grading, and student conduct.
7. Health, medical, and food services are available at additional cost; arrangements are made with the Cashier's Office.
8. Open University students are not eligible for financial aid, campus housing privileges, campus student employment, tutoring, participation in the Corps of Cadets, and watch-standing.
9. Open University students are not members of the Corps of Cadets and may not dress in uniform. Students will not be permitted to conduct business on campus or attend classes wearing shorts, tee shirts, sandals, or similar attire.
