- I. The California State Univerts Maritime Academycampus will adhere to the Donor Bill of Rights which has been endorsed by the Council for the Advancement and Support of Education (C.A.S.E.)and the Association of Fundraising Professionals.
- II. Purpose A Donor Bill of Rights
  - A. Philanthropy is based on voluntary action for the common good. It is a tradition of giving and sharing that is primary to the quality of life. To assure that philanthropy merits the respect and trust of the general public, and that donors and prospective donors can have full confidence in the netor-profit organizations and causes they are asked to support, we declare that all donors have these rights:
    - 1. To be informed of the organization's mission, of the way the organization intends to use donated resources, and of its capacity to use donation efficiently for their intended purposes.
    - 2. To be informed of the identity of those serving on the organization's governing board, and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgmeentstewardship responsibilities.
    - 3. To have access to the organization's most recent financial statements.
    - 4. To be assured their gifts will be used for the purpose for which they were given.
    - 5. To receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition.
    - 6. To be assured that information about their donation and with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.
    - 7. To expect that all relationships with individuals representing organizations of interest to the donor will be professional s B. History
