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- The use of the “Outcomes” module by Campus Labs has proved to be more unfriendly and difficult than initially expected. There are ways in which it does not communicate effectively with Moodle and with Peoplesoft, and it is unable to disaggregate some of our assessment data to the granular level we desire. There was not a lot of traction by the faculty as a whole since this platform was an “add-on” and not fully integrated into Moodle. It is expected that with the adoption of a new LMS, such assessment tools will be better integrated and easier to use. In the meantime, IWAC can get by on its own data collection and distribution means, with assistance from the Director of Institutional Research.

Again, the committee worked very hard this year to achieve our stated objectives, and we look forward to continued progress and improvement in the semesters to come.
